Iquique, Chile, December 3, 2015 - From December 6-13, Iquique, Chile will receive the world's best bodyboarders to compete in the 2015 Iquique Para Todos ISA World Bodyboard Championship.

More than a dozen countries from around the globe will gather to represent their nations in the world-renowned waves of La Punta 1.

Here are the 10 things you need to know about the 2015 ISA World Bodyboard Championship:

1. The ISA World Championship

The 2015 ISA World Bodyboard Championship is an Olympic style event where the world's best bodyboarders converge in Chile to compete for Medals in the name of their nations.

2. The Competition

The World Championship is a team competition with each National Team fielding up to seven athletes in the following categories: Open Men (3 athletes), Open Women (1), Junior Under-18 Boys (1), Junior Under-18 Girls (1) and Open Dropknee (1).

3. The Prize

The athletes compete for Individual Gold, Silver, Bronze, and Copper Medals and the World Team Championship Trophy, all with the honor of representing their respective countries.
