

WANGARATTA UNDERWAY WITH JACOBSON, SELLER, MILTHORPE, CHALCRAFT & COTTIER WINS

Wangaratta City Speedway's season is underway with a great night of racing for local divisions seeing two North East drivers win finals whilst three others were won by drivers from out of town. Geelong's Mark Seller, Melbourne based Garry Jacobson, Shepparton lady racer Belinda Chalcraft along with Junior racer Jack Milthorpe from Corowa and Craig Cottier from the Border were winners in the season opening.

Visiting open wheel division the Grand Prix Midgets were competing in the first round of their state series & three heats determined the field for the final with Trevor Perry winning the first & then 'Dunlop Series Supercar' driver Garry Jacobson winning the next two. Jacobson then went on to win the feature race from Chris Fowler with no other finishers.

Seller is a regular at coming to Wangaratta before his season starts in Ballarat & he thoroughly enjoyed himself as he went on to win three heats before taking victory in the final from youngster Josh Delarue & second year driver with only a handful of races under his belt Jason Keenan.

Like Seller in the Standards, Jack Milthorpe from Corowa won all three heats in the Junior Sedans before defeating rookie driver Daniel Powell in the final race for the day.

Belinda Chalcraft won all the heat races in the Open Ladies Sedans and went on to win the final ahead of Fleur Heiner & Alyce Iaria.

In the popular Sports Sedan division which will hold this seasons Victorian title in March, it would be Craig Cottier winning two of three heat events & Troy Frost the other before Craig Cottier sped home as the winner in the final ahead of brothers Liam Powell & James Powell.
