First time speedway winners score Sunday @ Nyora Raceway.

On a beautiful Autumn Sunday April 17th a number of drivers wrote themselves into the Nyora Raceway history books with their first ever feature wins here and for some, as in the case of Jamie-Lee Smith, it was her first feature winner ever.

Gippsland veteran Wayne Logue (pictured below courtesy Inactionphotos.com.au) took his first Wingless Sprint feature at Nyora after surviving an at times brutal event and almost constant pressure from Travis Millar a man familiar with Nyora's victory lane. Pakenham racer Renae Eastham drove brilliantly to record third place, the same position she occupied at the conclusion of the Intercity Signs ladies of the Dirt feature.

The main event saw a few incidents a couple of which involved Kelvin Toogood trying to launch over other competitors due to circumstances beyond his control. All in all it was a very exciting feature.

In the Ladies of the Dirt Wingless event Jamie-Lee Smith scored her maiden victory from Demelza Nettlefold and Eastham.



Unlimited sedans became the domain of Andrew Spink who took a comfortable win from Scott Angus and Ballarat visitor Phillip Le Poidevin in his first race back with a new car after a short break.

The Standard Saloon feature was a very tight affair with Andrew Phillips taking the narrowest of wins from Rob Bushell and Bruce Bullard who all crossed the line in very close company. Phillips lead almost from start to finish as those around him spun out left and right before regrouping and mounting a serious challenge for the lead over the closing laps to which Phillips repelled all.

Nyora raceway has only a couple of shows programmed to complete the season culminating with the annual Southern 2000 Bob Hickson Memorial for Unlimited Sedans on June 26th with a top line show of Wingless Sprints and Sedans also scheduled for May 22nd.
